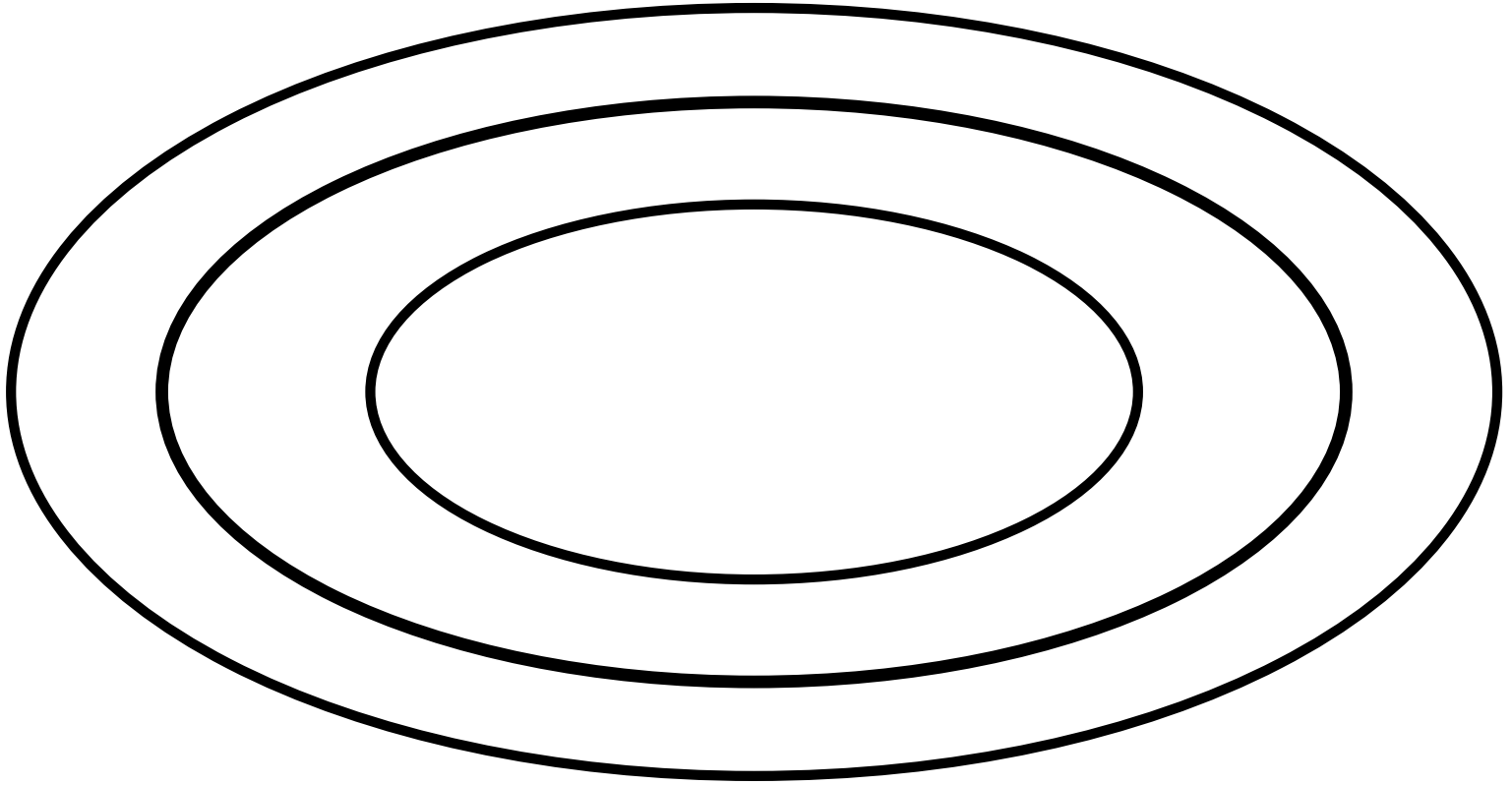

# Paella Puppet and Patterns Oval Fleece Noses

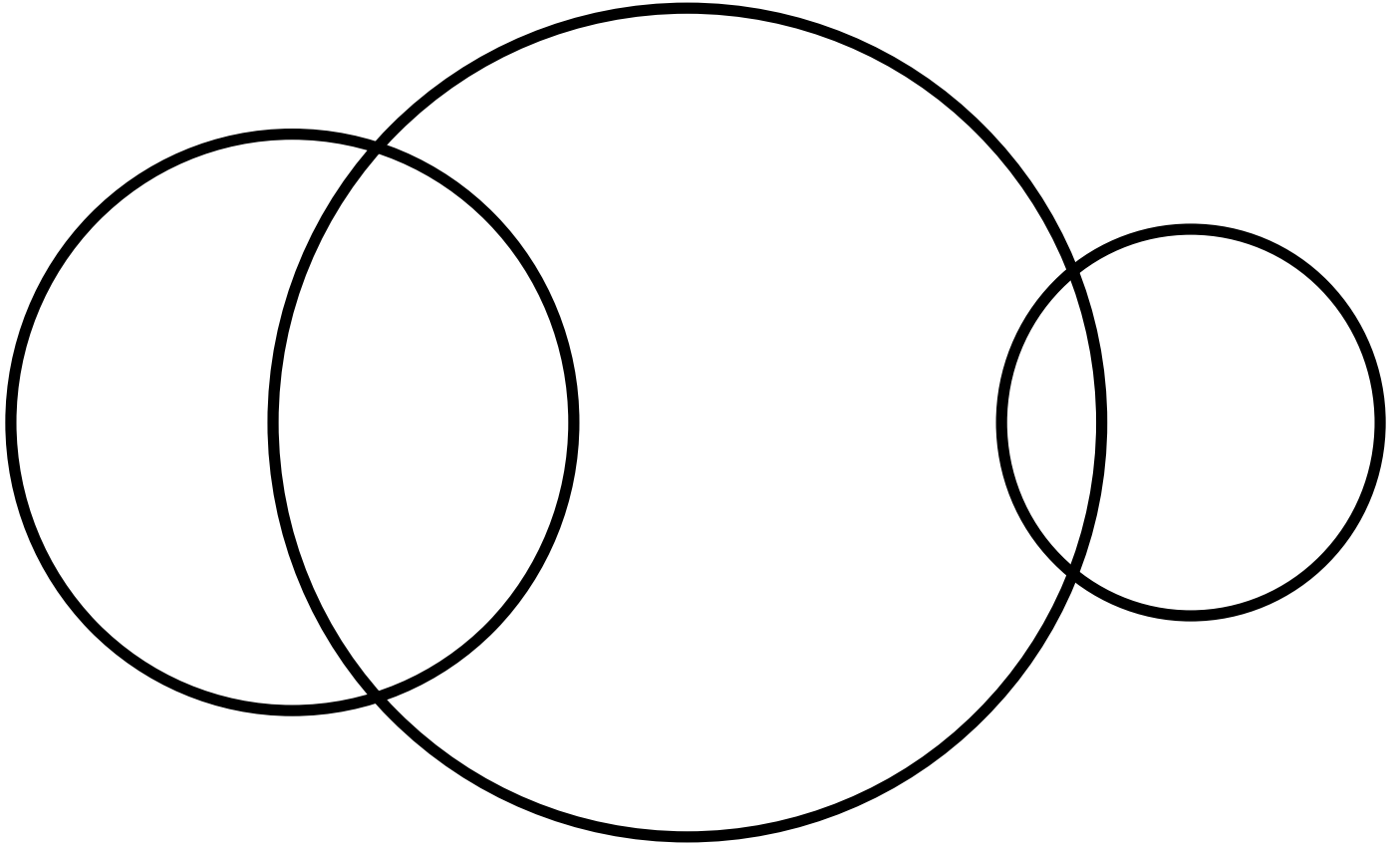


1. Cut 1 in fleece. Add 1/2 inch seam allowance if machine sewing.
2. Cut out a smaller piece of 1 inch foam so that when it sits on the fleece there is a 2 cm edge all round.
3. Sew all around the right sides together.





# Paella Puppet and Patterns Round Fleece Noses

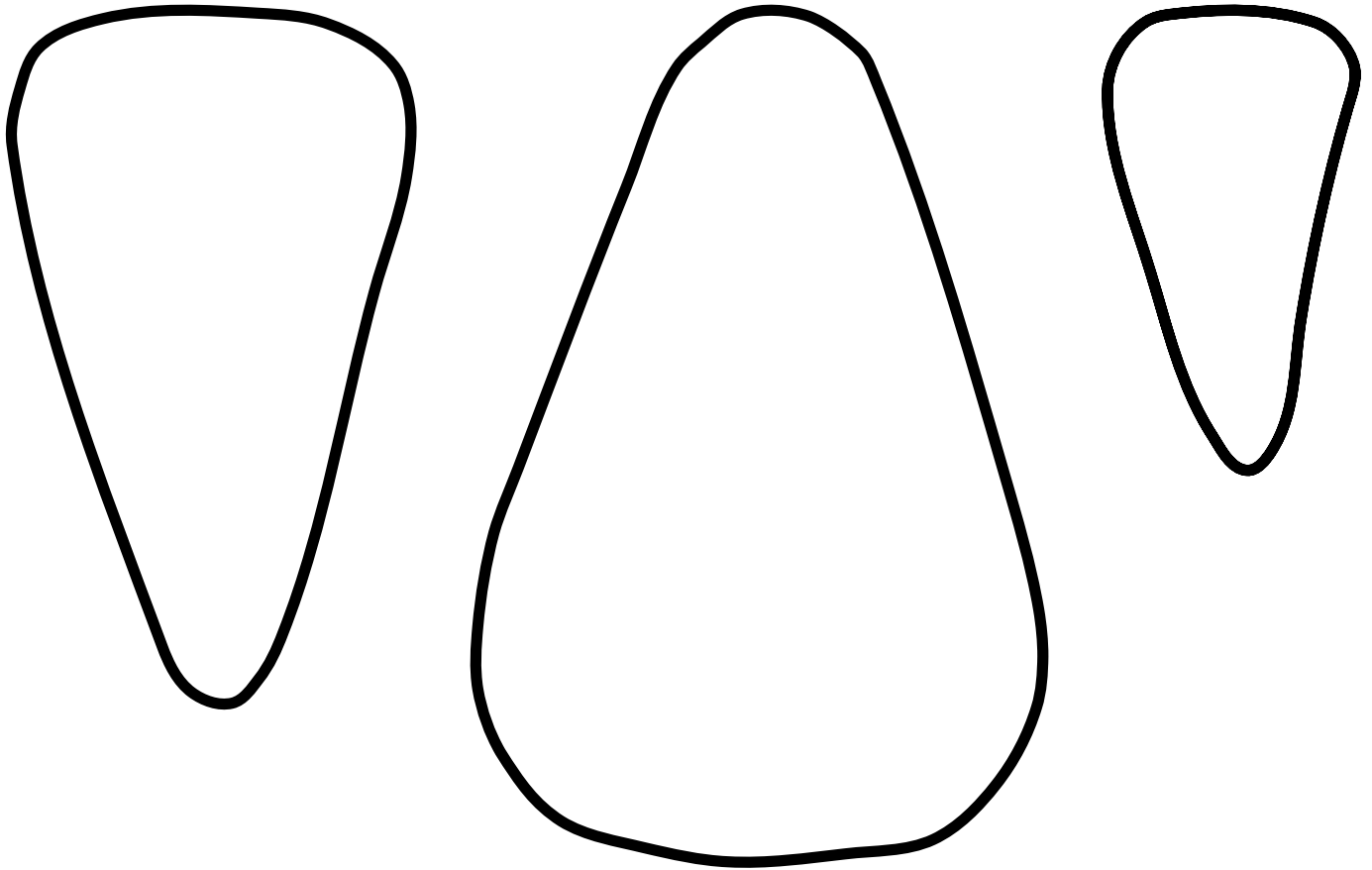


1. Cut 1 in fleece. Add 1/2 inch seam allowance if machine sewing.
2. Cut out a smaller piece of 1 inch foam so that when it sits on the fleece there is a 2 cm edge all round.
3. Sew all around the right sides together.





# Paella Puppet and Patterns Triangular Fleece Noses

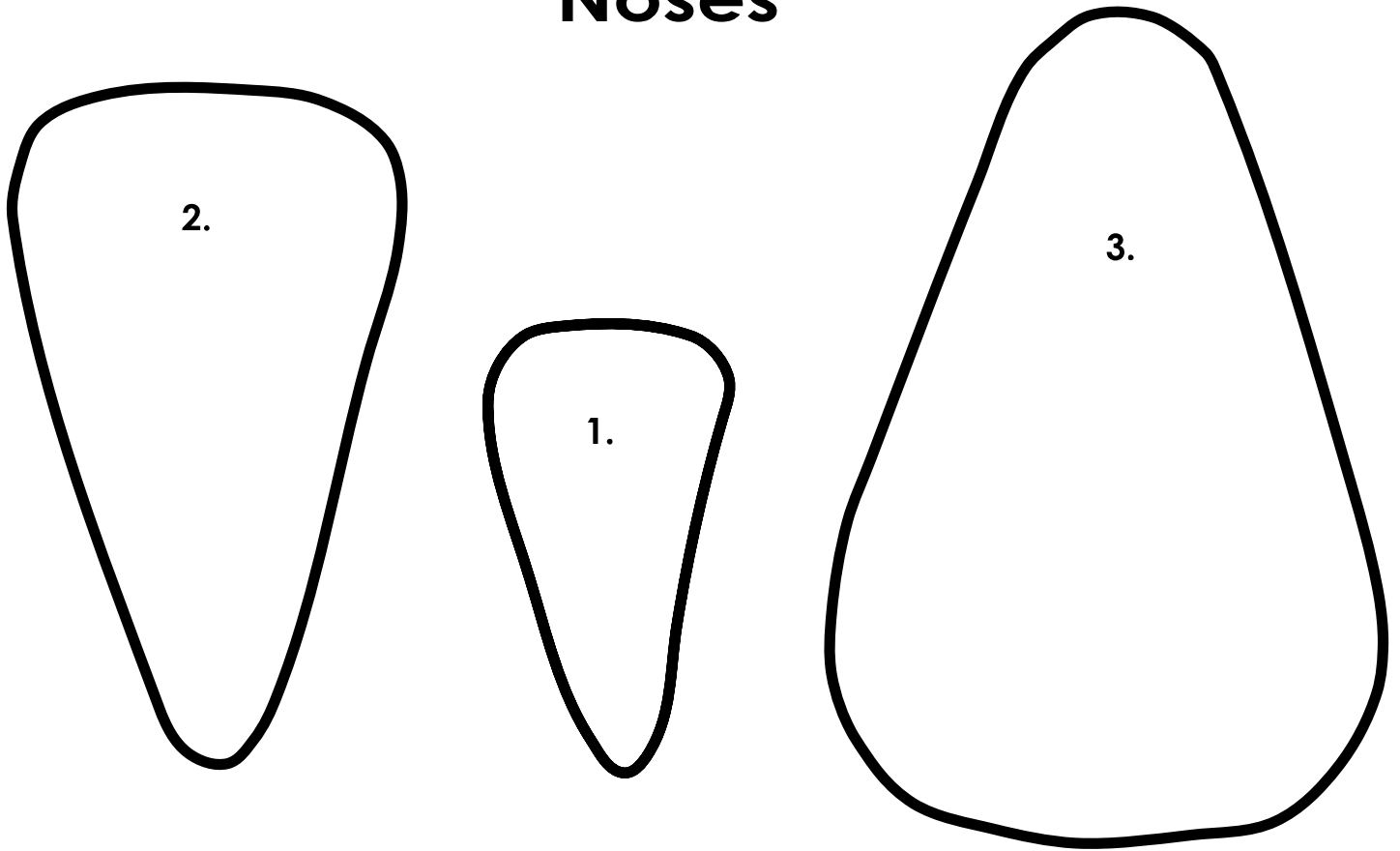


1. Cut 2 in fleece. Add 1/2 inch seam allowance if machine sewing
2. Sew all around right sides together
3. Cut small slit at the back
4. Turn right way out through the slit then stuff to desired size
5. Sew slit closed
6. You can create a nostril effect by making a stitch in the nostril position and pulling the thread tight. Secure at the back and repeat for the other side.





# Paella Puppet and Patterns Triangular Stripecy Fleece Noses



1. Cut strips of fleece around 1" wide and 6" long to fit No. 2 triangle nose. Larger strips or smaller for other sizes
2. Using sewing machine, sew strips together, right sides facing
3. Fold in half right sides together and draw around pattern onto fleece as a sewing guide
4. Cut away excess. Snip a hole in the back as shown to allow you to turn the nose the right way out. Turn.
5. Stuff to desired effect.
6. Sew closed the opening using hand stitch.
7. You can create a nostril effect by making a stitch in the nostril position and pulling the thread tight. Secure at the back and repeat for the other side.
